ANCIENT EGYPT,

Step into the world of the Pharaohs

Our **Ancient Egypt** workshop gives pupils a hands-on introduction to one of the world's most fascinating civilisations. Through storytelling, role-play and practical activities, pupils explore Egyptian culture, religion, daily life, beliefs and discoveries.

Activities may include:

DRESS-UP & ROLE-PLAY

Pupils have the opportunity to become characters from Ancient Egypt and help bring the story to life.

GODS OF EGYPT

Children discover the Egyptian gods and take on different roles to explore who they were and what they represented.

MEET THE KEY FIGURES

Discover some of the most famous names connected with Ancient Egypt, including **Tutankhamun, Cleopatra and Alexander the Great.**

CRACK THE HIEROGLYPHIC CODE

Working in pairs, pupils use hieroglyphic symbols to decipher names and solve a historical code.

EXPLORE TUTANKHAMUN'S TOMB

Using a hand-drawn plan of a typical Egyptian tomb, pupils work together to identify and label its different sections.

THE MYSTERY OF MUMMIFICATION

Explore the fascinating process of mummification and why the Ancient Egyptians believed preserving the body was so important.

HOWARD CARTER & THE LOST TOMB

Follow the story of Howard Carter and his search for the lost tomb of Tutankhamun.

Travel Costs

Travel costs are calculated based on the distance from the Isle of Wight to the school location.

- Mileage: Typically calculated at £0.55 per mile
- Ferry: Return vehicle crossing, typically £80–£120 for an off-island booking
- Estimated Total Return Travel Cost: £120–£160, rounded

Final travel costs will be confirmed at the time of booking and may vary depending on the location, ferry fares and mileage.

Workshop Format.

Schools can book **up to four workshops in a single day**, with each workshop lasting approximately **50 minutes**.

To ensure we can provide a fully immersive experience, the **same historical topic is delivered throughout the entire day**. We do not offer multiple different historical workshops on the same day, as each workshop requires a substantial amount of props, equipment, historical artefacts and costuming to create the complete experience.

Each workshop is designed for **up to 30 children**.

A key part of the experience is allowing pupils to become part of the story themselves. For each workshop, we can provide **up to 30 individual costumes**, enabling children to dress as historical characters and actively participate in bringing the chosen period to life.

This format allows us to create a consistent, engaging and immersive historical experience for every class throughout the school day.
